## Does using 'real life' maths in the classroom improve students' GCSE maths attainment?

We're currently recruiting for secondary schools to take part in our new Maths in Context project, a partnership between the Education Endowment Foundation and Money Advice Service, to see if teaching students maths in 'real world' financial contexts can improve students' attainment at maths GCSE level, as well as their ability to manage money more effectively.

The project is a two-armed randomised control trial, involving **130 secondary schools**, 65 active, and 65 as a control group.

Active schools will receive **educational support** and a series of specially designed **lesson plans** to implement with support. Control schools will receive all resources at the end of the project.
