The STEM Club Quality Mark is available to all UK schools and colleges, applications can be submitted throughout the academic year.

The application asks if your STEM Club:

Leadership and organisation

- Is coordinated by a named individual
- Is supported by senior management in the school
- Meets at least once per month for a total of at least 1 hour
- Runs for at least one term per year

Educators and resources

- Provides activities that appeal to a diverse range of interests and abilities
- Links to real world problems or scenarios
- Makes use of high-quality resources

Students and learning

- Enables students to take on different roles within a team
- Strengthens employability skills as identified by the Skills Builder Framework
- Improves practical skills
- Improves curiosity, creativity, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills
- Improves knowledge in one or more STEM subjects
- Positively impacts students' confidence
- Positively impacts students' personal attributes (such as resilience and diplomacy)

Working with others

- Promotes STEM subjects, knowledge and learning with the community e.g. families, conservation groups, WI, scouts etc.

Evidence of impact

- Collects evidence of, and regularly assesses, impact on student members
